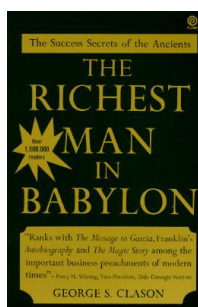

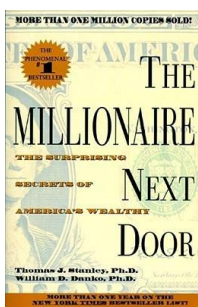
## [The Richest Man In Babylon](#)

A collection of simple parables set in ancient Babylon. Each one helps you understand an essential element of money management.



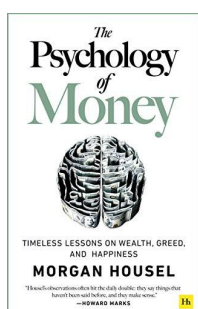
## [The Millionaire Next Door](#)

The authors studied actual millionaires in America and discovered consistent character traits and habits amongst them. It's a fascinating exposé of something you thought you already understood.



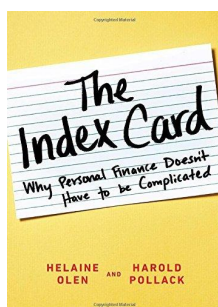

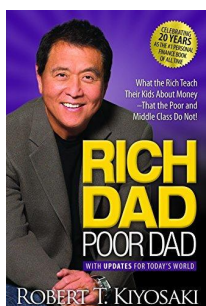
## [The Index Card](#)
